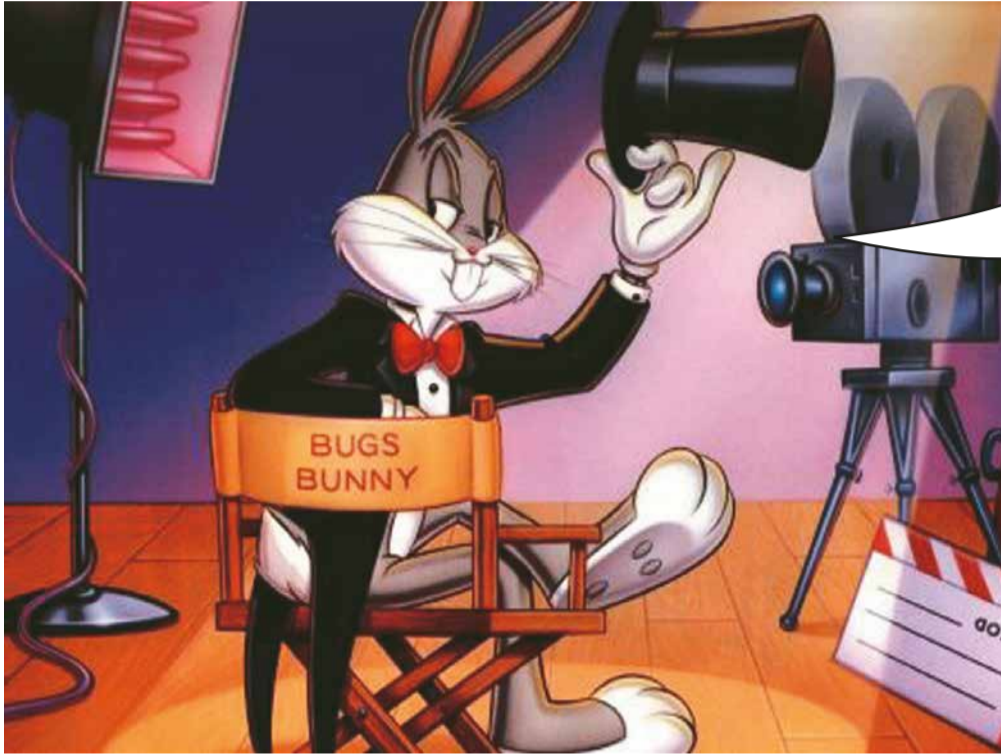

TAMER: We are 26 students as "The Nifty Fifties" musical cast and all of the students are participating in the dances, chorus and acting.

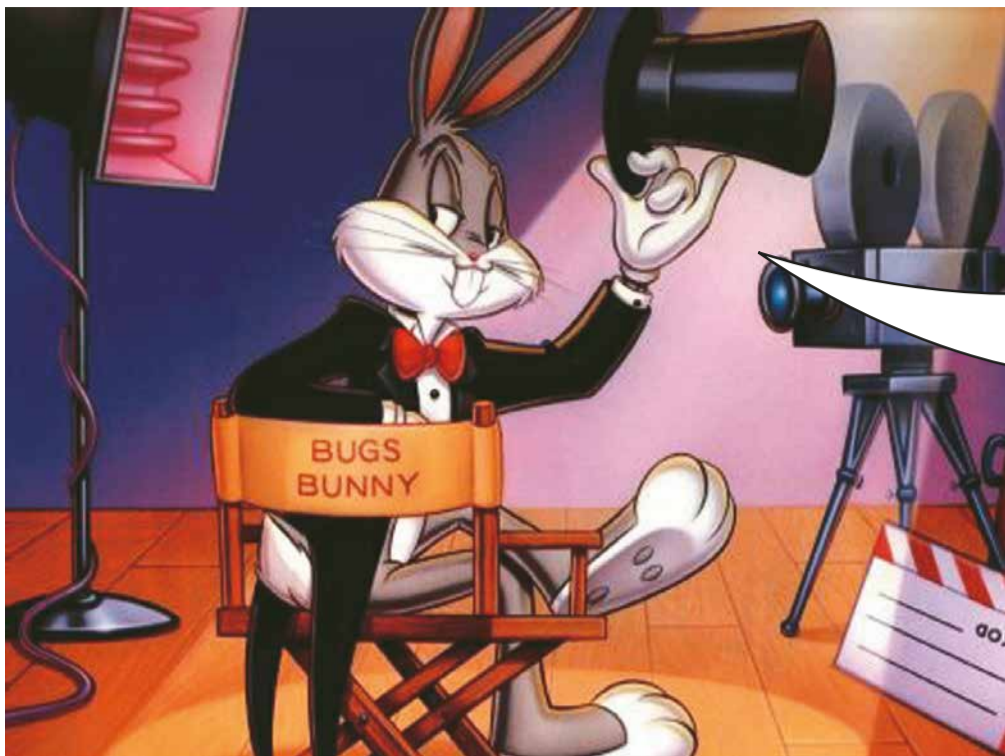
● **This year the musical is being taken more seriously, do you think it will achieve the success you are hoping?**

related to the subject and also it is a polyphonic musical but beyond this we all believe that we'll be successful.

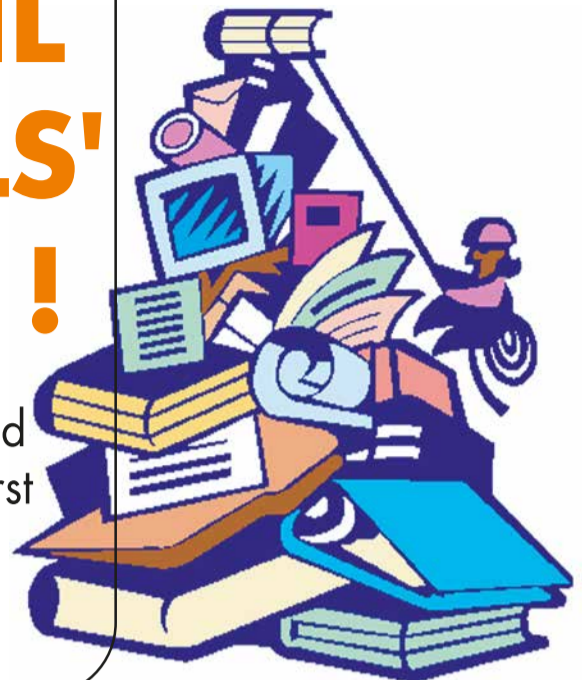
● **The staff are all professional, aren't they?**

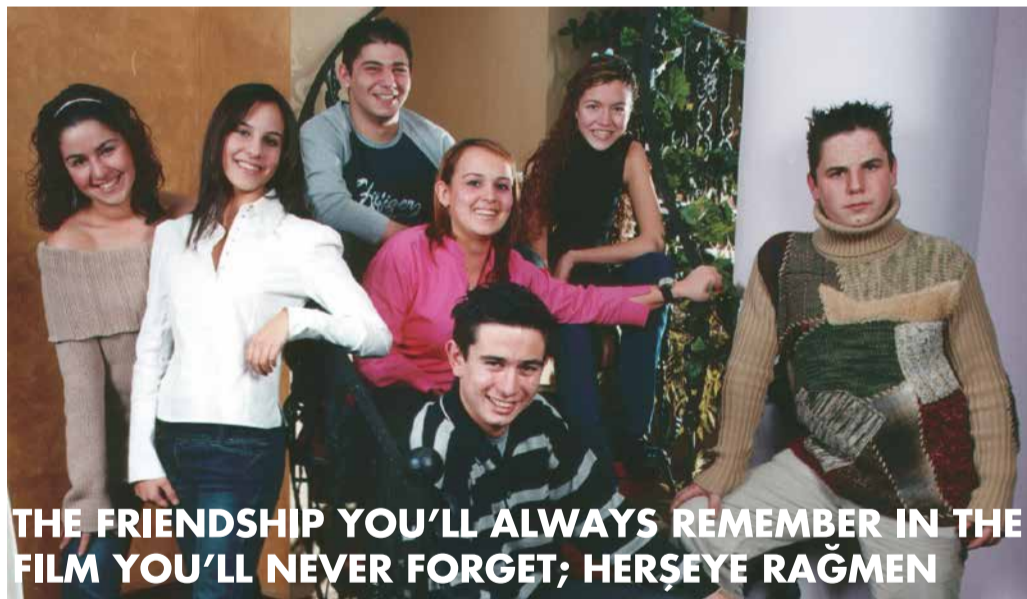

But at the end unfortunately she dies.The story is about how important a friendship is.

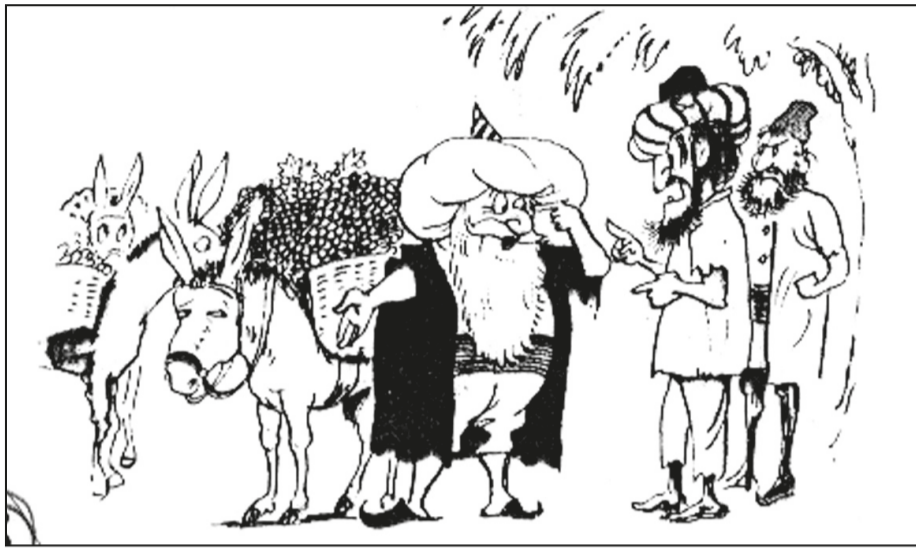
ALL THAT JAZZ

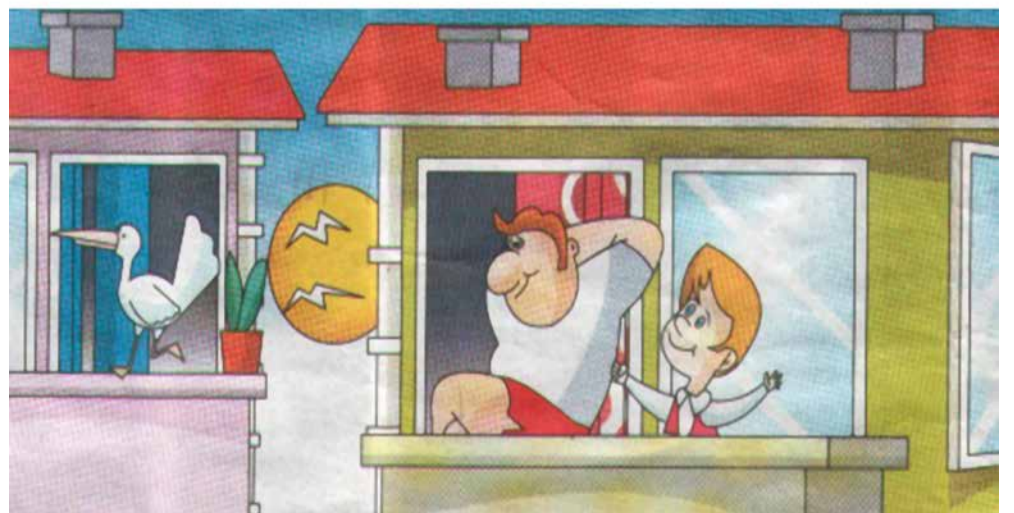
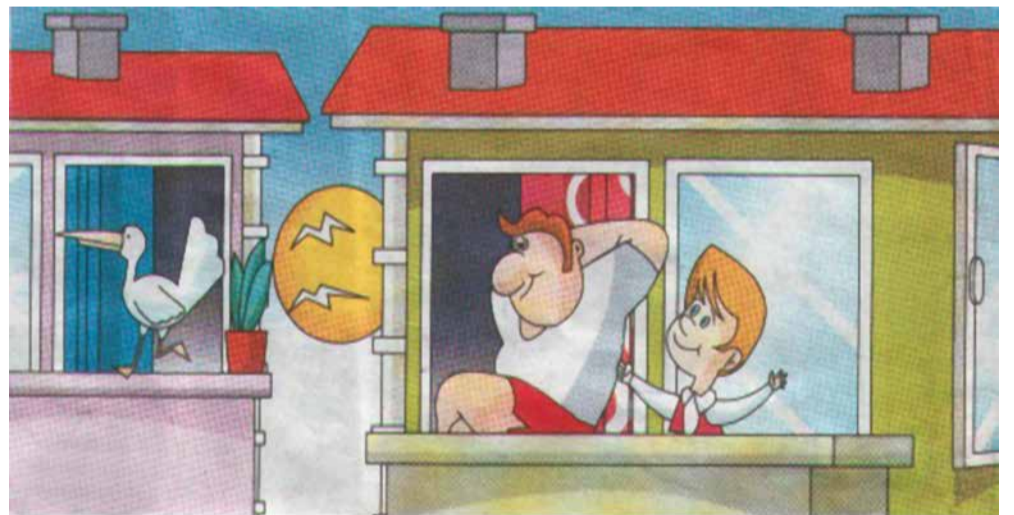

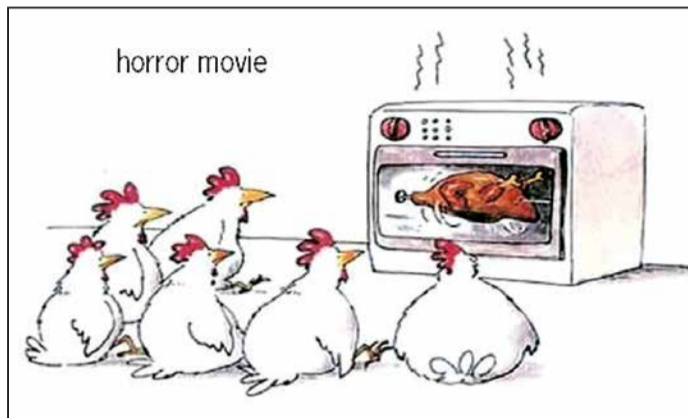

LITTLE MUSHROOMS

● When you first came to İTK did you ever think that you'd be the head of English?

ARTUNER: No, I never thought of it.

● Why do you think you were chosen? Because there're lots of teachers who have been in this school for many years but you were chosen. Why?

ARTUNER: I don't know. I think you should ask this question to the people who assigned me for the post. I think they have observed the way I worked and then they decided to ask me to take the position. But there are some other teachers who have the same capacity who are very hardworking and who are very conscientious I know this.

ARTUNER: It is very hard to carry it because our students will be the graduates of a private school and they must have the capacity to express themselves very well in English. That's the reason I give great importance to debates and presentations, that's the reason I always speak English with my students.

● What did you do as a job before coming to İTK and which university did you graduate from?

ARTUNER: I didn't do anything; I graduated from İTK went to university (9 Eylül English Department), graduated from university I came to İTK. So this is a second home for me.

● Did you have ups and downs in your career?

ARTUNER: To be honest no I didn't.

● Why do you give this much importance to 'current affairs'?

ARTUNER: TV channels are full of magazine programmes. Sometimes all of us watch these programmes but what I see is we always discuss moral decline in the society you know. Our young generation unfortunately does not know much about the things going on. So if things are happening in Iraq, if things are happening somewhere in this country we should know what's going on. You shouldn't focus on one thing only, you should know many things happening around, that's why I give great importance to current affairs.

● If you had a chance would you be a teacher again?

ARTUNER: I love teaching, I love being with my students-yes I would be a teacher again.

● What kind of social activities do you like the most?

ARTUNER: I love playing tennis, swimming and cooking (if I'm in the right mood)

● You are never tired! We always see you running around the buildings. How can you be so energetic?

ARTUNER: It's my lifestyle. Every morning I thank God because I'm healthy and I become very energetic. I feel happy!

● Have you been abroad?

ARTUNER: Yes I have been to France, Italy, Spain, Washington, New York and Miami I love going abroad!

When I saw the film first I didn't like it and become angry with myself, but later I liked it.

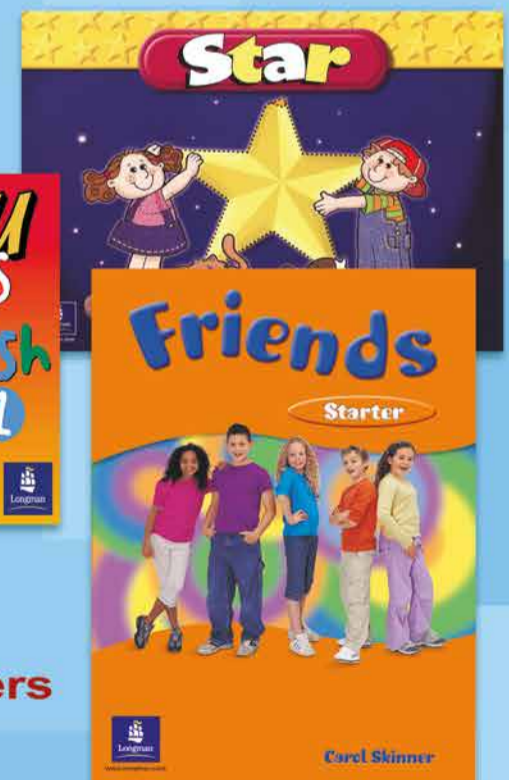
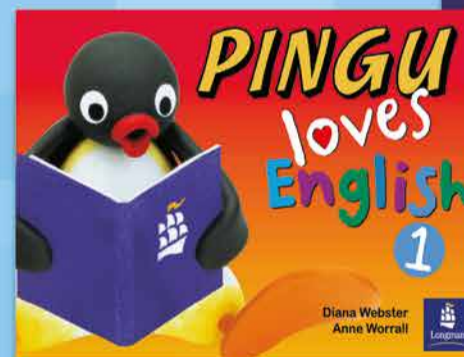
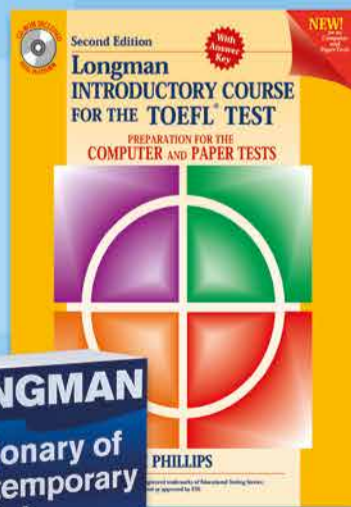
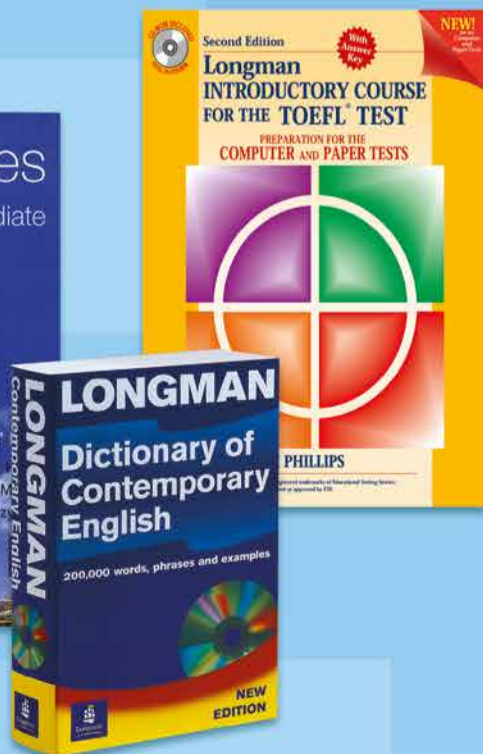
● Are you going to act in a film again?

What is the capoeira?

TEN: In disagreements, fight fairly. Please No name calling.

ELEVEN: Don't judge people by their relatives.

TWELVE: Talk slowly but think quickly.

THIRTEEN: When someone asks you a question you don't want to answer, smile and ask, "Why do you want to know?"

FOURTEEN: Remember that great love and great achievements involve great risk.

FIFTEEN: Say "bless you" when you hear someone sneeze.

SIXTEEN: When you lose, don't lose the lesson.

SEVENTEEN: Remember the three R's:

Respect for self;
Respect for others;
Responsibility for all your actions.

EIGHTEEN: Don't let a little dispute injure a great friendship.

NINETEEN: When you realize you've made a mistake, take immediate steps to correct it.

TWENTY: Smile when picking up the phone. The caller will hear it in your voice.

TWENTY ONE: Spend some time alone.
